Congrats on making it through your child's first few weeks of school! As a busy parent, we want to assure you, great things are coming!

Who is HASA?

We are truly a family. HASA, or Home and School Association, is a parent organization that provides, through fundraisers and parent contributions, opportunities for our students to bond with classmates and our community, and affords our staff and students with many of their educational needs.

What does HASA do?

We serve and help shepherd our St. Joseph family, through our fundraising events, social activities, and our lunch program. Several times throughout the school year HASA hosts events for the students, their families and most often, the surrounding communities and Parishes. This year we have two primary fundraising events, our Pumpkin Fall Festival and our Spring Merchant Bingo. The funds from these events help maintain the lunch program, offer additional funds for classroom needs, and provide entertainment to our students throughout the year.

Where/When does HASA meet?

We generally meet right before school is out or after school for about an hour in the St. Joseph Bennett Hall (lunchroom), Parish Center (PK rooms), St Martin's House (next to school) or similar location. Our goal is to offer meeting locations wherever it is convenient to members of HASA. We are always kid friendly. Our meetings take place every other month starting in September on the 3rd Wednesday of the month. How do I join HASA?

Each family at St. Joseph is asked to pay a \$25 HASA membership fee. These funds are used in a similar way as our fundraisers. If you choose to chair or co-chair an event the meetings to discuss event details will be held at your convenience.
